Election of Presidential Electors

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at an election to be held in the several towns, villages, wards, and election districts of the State of Wisconsin, on November 2, 2004, ten electors for President and Vice-President of the United States, one for each congressional district and two for the state at-large, are to be elected. The names of presidential electors do not appear on the ballot, but each vote cast for a presidential candidate is a vote for the electors of the candidate. Independent candidates for president or vice-president may circulate nomination papers beginning August 1, 2004, and must file nomination papers with the State Elections Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 7, 2004. The State Elections Board is located at 17 West Main Street, Suite 310, Madison, Wisconsin.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in the several towns, villages, wards, and election districts of the State of Wisconsin, at a primary to be held on Tuesday, September 14, 2004, and at an election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2004, the following officers are to be nominated and elected:


