

ACCEPTING PROPOSALS

The Green County Highway Department will be accepting proposals for pulverizing pavement on various roads, all within Green County. A portion of this work may be used for L.R.I.P. projects in the Village of Browntown (East Park Street, CTH M to the east), Town of New Glarus (Zentner Road, CTH H and STH 39), Town of Albany (Dunphy Road, STH 104 and CTH E), Town of Exeter (Tunnel Road, Argue Road and Linden Road), Town of Mt. Pleasant (Schneeberger Road, CTH EE and Purintun Road), Village of New Glarus (1st Street, 6th Avenue and 11th Avenue), Village of Monticello (Washington Street, Greenview Avenue and Oakridge Avenue), Town of Cadiz (Ullom Road, Melvin Road and CTH B), Town of Jefferson (Town Center Road, CTH S to Brunkow Road), and Town of Monroe (Aebly Road, Iliff Road to Benkert Road).

Proposals will be accepted until 10:30 a.m. on March 8, 2010.
