

Notice of Spring Election and Sample Ballots — April 7, 2009

OFFICE OF THE GREEN COUNTY CLERK TO THE ELECTORS OF GREEN COUNTY:

Notice is hereby given of a spring election to be held in Green County, on the 7th day of April, 2009, at which the officers named below shall be chosen. The names of the candidates for each office to be voted for, whose nominations have been certified to or filed in this office, are given under the title of the office, each in its proper column, together with the questions submitted to a vote, for a referendum, in the sample ballot below.

INFORMATION TO ELECTORS

Upon entering the polling place, an elector shall give his or her name and address before being permitted to vote. Where ballots are distributed to electors, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot. Upon being permitted to vote, the elector shall retire alone to a voting booth and cast his or her ballot except that an elector who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the elector's minor child or minor ward. An election official may inform the elector of the proper manner for casting a vote, but the official may not in any manner advise or indicate a particular voting choice.


At the spring election, where **optical scan** voting is used, the elector shall fill in the oval or connect the arrow next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for each office for whom he or she intends to vote. Where **touch screen** voting systems are used, the elector shall depress the button next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for each office for whom he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the **optical scan** ballot, the elector shall write in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided and fill in the oval or connect the arrow on the write-in line. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the **touch screen** ballot, the elector shall type in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. On referendum questions where **optical scan** voting is used, the elector shall fill in the oval or connect the arrow next to "yes" if in favor of the question, or the elector shall fill in the oval or connect the arrow next to "no" if opposed to the question. On referendum questions where **touch screen** voting is used, the elector shall depress the button next to "yes" if in favor of the question, or the elector shall depress the button next to "no" if opposed to the question.

The vote should not be cast in any other manner. If the elector spoils an **optical scan** ballot, he or she shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one elector. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the elector shall return it to the election official, who shall issue a proper ballot in its place. The elector may spoil a **touch screen** ballot at the voting station. Not more than five minutes time shall be allowed inside a voting booth. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the elector in casting his or her vote may be taken into the booth and copied. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked.

After casting his or her vote, the elector shall leave the voting booth, insert the **optical scan** ballot in the voting device and leave the polling place promptly. After an official **touch screen** ballot is marked, the elector shall leave the polling place promptly.

An elector may select an individual to assist in casting his or her vote if the elector declares to the presiding official that he or she is unable to read, has difficulty reading, writing or understanding English or that due to disability is unable to cast his or her ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the elector's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the elector.

To vote for the candidate of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name like this . To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and darken the oval to the LEFT of the person's name like this .

ALBANY SCHOOL DISTRICT

I. INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Albany, Green and Rock Counties, Wisconsin that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of essential school building and safety improvements including energy efficient roof replacements and heating/cooling system upgrades.

Question I.

II. RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP COMMENCING WITH THE 2009-10 SCHOOL YEAR

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Albany, Green and Rock Counties, Wisconsin, that the final school district budgets for the 2009-10 through the 2012-13 school years shall include, on a nonrecurring basis, the following amounts in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 (2m) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of paying district operation and maintenance costs: in 2009-10 an amount of \$250,000, in 2010-11 an amount of \$450,000, in 2011-12 an amount of \$500,000, and in 2012-13 an amount of \$550,000.

Question II.

Shall the School Board of the School District of Albany be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91(2m) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the 2009-10 through 2011-12 school years, on a nonrecurring basis, by the following amounts for the purpose of paying district operation and maintenance costs: in 2009-10 an amount of \$250,000, in 2010-11 an amount of \$450,000, in 2011-12 an amount of \$500,000, and in 2012-13 an amount of \$550,000 as provided in the foregoing resolution?
